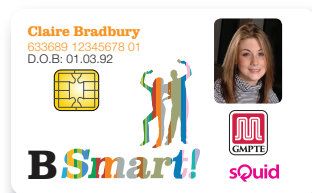

BSmart and pay for activities the cashless way

The BSmart card – it's a great new cashless way to pay for a host of activities at venues in and around Bolton, including attractions, dance, drama and sports clubs, leisure centres, libraries, museums, youth centres and more. Check out a growing list of providers, including Bolton Arena, Bolton Community Leisure Centres, BCOM, Bolton Lads & Girls Club, Bolton Wanderers Football in the Community, Casey Lee Jolleys, Castle Hill & Farnworth Youth Centres, Excel Centre, Harmony Youth, Smithills Hall, Smithills Sports Centre and more.

Easy to top up, easy to use, it's the card just for you

BSmart – it's 3 cards in one

BSmart, is more than just a card to pay for activities, it also acts as ID for concessionary bus travel (currently only on Arriva Buses*) and your library card too

BSmart and swim for free!

If you are a Bolton Resident and aged 16 or under then your BSmart card entitles you to free swimming in Bolton Community Leisure pools through the Freebie scheme. For details visit www.bolton.gov.uk/freebie

How can I BSmart?

Step 1

Download an application form from www.bolton.gov.uk/bsmart (click the Sign Up link) or visit your nearest leisure centre, library, or One Stop Shop to pick one up.

Step 2

Take your completed application form to your nearest library or the One Stop Shops in Bolton, Farnworth, Horwich or Westhoughton Town halls. For more information call 01204 334123. A photograph will be taken and your BSmart card will be posted out to you.

Remember to bring proof of your identity and address with your application form. e.g. birth certificate, bank statement. If you're under 16 we'll need to see proof of age and for your parent / guardian to have signed the form.

Step 3

Your BSmart card has arrived, now visit www.bolton.gov.uk/bsmart and click the "My BSmart sQuid account" card link to create your personal BSmart sQuid account. **You will need to have your own email address prior to creating the account.**

Step 4

Once you have created your BSmart sQuid account, follow the links to register your BSmart card. You will need to put in your full 16 digit card number (which starts 633689) and the three digit security number from the back of the card. Once the card is registered then the card can be topped up with funds* to start paying for activities at registered BSmart providers. Your account will show the funds as pending at this stage.

Step 5

Visit a BSmart Provider, place your card against the sQuid reader and any funds shown as pending will be downloaded onto the card. Choose the activity you want to do, the cost will be debited from your account. Check out what you have spent at any time by logging on and checking your account.

*Young people aged 13 to 16 in receipt of/entitled to free school meals, or looked after (in foster care or a care home) are eligible for their card to be credited with a government bursary of £35 per month (through to March 2009). For more information call 01204 334917.

NB:

For library membership you simply need to take your BSmart card to a local library and register at the reception counter.

For Freebie (free swimming) or other leisure activities at Bolton Community Leisure centres simply take your BSmart card to a local centre and register at reception.

For concessionary bus travel, show your BSmart card to the conductor each time you travel (Only valid on Arriva buses (at date of publication) and if under 16 at date of travel).
